

## **GUIDELINES TO APPLY FOR AZEF FUNDING**

### **Subsidy for students:**

Students do not need to present to qualify for funding, however, we are interested in knowing whether students will be presenting.

To apply for a student subsidy please provide the following documents:

- Whether or not you submitted an abstract for poster / oral presentation at this year's meeting.
- Letter of motivation (maximum 2 pages Times New Roman 12) specifying which University & Department you come from, your highest degree, current level of study and where you originate from: South Africa, SADAC, other African countries, Europe, why do you want to attend AZEF and why do you need (additional) financial support to be able to do so).
- Copy of your registration papers or student card
- Abstract of your contribution as submitted (if applicable).

### **Subsidies for representatives from conservation agencies / Department of Agriculture:**

To apply for a subsidy please provide a letter of motivation (1 page max.) with the following information:

- the organisation for which you work and your designation
- how long have you been in this position
- brief job description (half page maximum Times New Roman 12)
- relevance of AZEF or Arid Zones for your work
- reason for requiring of outside funding (why is the attendance at AZEF not funded by the organisation?)
- if you have attended AZEF in the past and when was the last time you did so
